ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP Section 1. VOTING MEMBERSHIP

Voting membership shall consist of members of State Garden Clubs that are affiliated with members of NGC.

ADOPTED BY 2/3 VOTE

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP Section 1. VOTING MEMBERSHIP, A. Eligibility

A State Garden Club shall have been organized for a minimum of one year, shall have a minimum membership of ten (10) clubs and shall be recommended by the Director of the Region in which it is located.

ADOPTED BY 2/3 VOTE

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. VOTING MEMBERSHIP, B. Application

Application shall be submitted to the NGC Board of Directors through the Director of the Region in which the State Garden Club is located. from the State Garden Club. Application shall be accompanied by per capita dues and a typewritten list of names and addresses of state officers in order of rank, and state chairmen; and names of member clubs in alphabetical order including the names and addresses of the Presidents.

ARTICLE VII – DUES, FEES AND CONTRIBUTIONS Section 1. DUES, A.

4. State Garden Clubs failing to remit dues by October 31 shall be excluded from any tabulations used to determine NGC Awards and shall not be eligible to submit Scholarship applicant(s).

ARTICLE VIII – OFFICERS- ELIGIBILITY Section 1. ELECTED OFFICERS

G. Officers shall be elected for a term of two (2) years, or until their successors are elected. No elected officer shall serve more than one term in the same office except

the Recording Secretary who may serve non-consecutive terms and the Treasurer who may serve no more than five (5) consecutive terms.

ARTICLE XVI - COMMITTEES Section 5. MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

The Membership Committee shall consist of a chairman appointed by the President with a minimum of six (6) members on the committee. The First Vice President/President elect shall serve as ex officio member of this committee.

ARTICLE XVI - COMMITTEES Section 6. ORGANIZATION STUDY COMMITTEE

The Organization Study Committee shall consist of the Third Vice President as Chairman and no more than eight members appointed by the President. The Vice-Presidents <u>Second-Vice President</u>, the Parliamentarian and the Executive Director shall attend the meetings and participate except for the right to make motions and the right to vote. <u>The First Vice-President may attend as a guest.</u>
